Are licensees required to accept digital driver licenses as a legal proof of ID?

No, this is not a requirement. However, if licensees want to accept digital driver licenses (also known as Mobile IDs and mDL) they may do so **only if** they have the legal scanning software to verify the ID.

Licensees that want to accept digital driver licenses can do so by downloading the “GET Mobile Verify” app, which must be used to verify digital driver licenses. **Digital driver licenses must not be accepted without the proper software for verifying and logging the ID.**
